Assessment of students with visual impairments and ...

The Bartimeus Center in Holland has published a test for the blind called the Intelligence Test for Visually Impaired Children. It is said to be based on Thurstone's theory. Standardized on the entire Dutch-speaking braille-reading population of Holland and Belgium (about 156 children) It has both verbal and tactile performance subtests, and is published in Dutch, German and English.

Variables Influencing Emotional Intelligence of Visually ...
